### *What some of the disciples did with what Jesus did for them...*

John 21:1-3

Jesus didn't rebuke Peter or the disciples for going fishing. God can use any action of faith to reveal the next step of His will.

In the quiet and beauty of creation, the voice of God can be heard...

As in the beginning, fear of failure and a focus on what was done wrong is still driving Peter.

John 21:7-9

v 10-14

Going fishing, the disciples caught more than they were fishing for. Love, acceptance, provision and awe and wonder filled their fearful hearts.

**Jesus never will leave things undone. From a place of acceptance and provision, Jesus can address the one thing that could get in the way of our future – our past.**

v15 ...Love looks like discipling/feeding young believers.

v16... Love looks like furnishing pastures for Gods people.

v17... Love looks like discipling/feeding mature believers as well.

Through this fishing trip, Jesus provided enough resources to allow them to stay and pray in Jerusalem till Pentecost. (Some 50 days of provision)
