*If you had an older sibling, you have a rich understanding of scapegoating.*  
scape-goat – *noun* - a person who is blamed for the wrongdoing of another.

**Lev. 16:2**

God sees a container of Manna - the answer to a complaining, distrusting people.  
The stone Tablets of the Law that the children of Israel broke.  
The almond rod that budded represents the children of Israel's rebellion.

**Lev. 16:2** God looks down at the Ark of the Covenant and sees the **blood which covers:**

**(1)** the stone tablets, which represent the failure of keeping the Law.

**(2)** the manna, which represents the distrust of God's provision.

**(3)** the rod that budded, which represents the rebellion of the people.

Jesus' blood was shed and established you as an honored heir, not a sinner whose sins are covered, but the recipient of a covenant where they've been REMOVED!

The scapegoat is a natural representation of what was accomplished spiritually in the Holy of Holies.
