Journey to the CROSS

Equality Act (H.R.5).

- Prohibits an individual from being denied access to a shared facility, accordance with the individual's gender identity
- Requires doctors to provide life-altering and often irreversible hormones and surgeries to adolescents without parent involvement
- Prohibits efforts to address pre-existing psychological issues in adolescents before moving forward with "gender identity" medical procedures
- Requires insurers to provide coverage for sex change operations
- Eliminates girls' and women's sports by allowing biological boys to compete in girls' sports
- Requires churches to make their public gathering places also available for gender-altering celebrations
