**2021 IMPACT** – *Identity*

Performance driven service to God – A “you owe me” mindset that keeps us from knowing the heart of our Father.

NLT - Luke 15:1-3

PARABLE 1&2 -Luke 15:4-10 The Lost Sheep and The Lost Coin...The diligent pursuit in finding the lost (the sinner) and rejoicing when what was lost is found!

PARABLE #3. Luke 15:11-12 The younger son represents the sinner, the outcast, the crowd. The older son represents the religious, the self-righteous, the Pharisees.

Col. 1:21

By writing the check, the father removed himself from the son’s negativity and power of being AGAINST something. Now, the focus will be his choices and himself.

God’s love goes beyond rebellion and rejection.  
God’s love has an expectation of REPENTANCE.

Luke 15:13-17

Hunger got him to repent. God can use anything! A natural road sign of a spiritual answer. Hunger for HOME!

In his rebellion he wasn’t himself. The repentant man was the real man, not the prodigal.

The son’s idea of repentance: Luke 15:18-19

The father’s idea towards a repentant heart. Luke 15:20-24
